Defense Community Champions National Honorees Recognized at Defense Communities National Summit.

Association of Defense Communities (ADC) and Navy Federal Credit Union recognize four national honorees for making a difference in defense communities.

Washington, D.C. – The <u>Association of Defense Communities</u> (ADC), together with <u>Navy Federal Credit</u> <u>Union</u>, recognized Dr. Lucy Greene of Valdosta, Ga., Kimberly Huth of St. Clair County, Ill. and Frederick Mueller of Sierra Vista, Ariz. as 2023 Defense Community Champions National Honorees. Sharene Brown was the inaugural recipient of the National Impact Award.

Defense Community Champions is a program that aims to recognize individuals who make a difference in defense communities through deeds big and small. There were 17 local champions recognized, three of whom were selected as national honorees. The program presented is by ADC in partnership with Navy Federal Credit Union.

We had inspiring nominations from across the country, and these individuals were chosen for going above and beyond for their defense communities," said Karen Holt, president of ADC. "They are all strong advocates for their local installations and promote collaboration between their base and community."

Dr. Lucy Greene founded Moody Support Team with her late husband, Parker Greene, to honor the airmen of Moody Air Force Base. She has been a staunch supporter of military members for over 50 years.

Kimberly Huth serves as Executive Director of Military Affairs for St. Clair County, Ill. Through this role and other engagements, Huth helps deliver programs that touch all four services and the U.S. Coast Guard, supporting over 17,000 service members.

Frederick Mueller, former mayor of Sierra Vista, Ariz., led the city to numerous environmental wins and has been an advocate for military members in the Fort Huachuca region.

Sharene Brown, Spouse of the 22nd Chief of Staff of the Air Force, was the first individual to receive the National Impact Award. She was recognized for her dedication and contributions to defense communities across the nation.

The three national honorees were recognized at the Defense Communities National Summit on Tuesday, March 7 in Arlington, VA.
